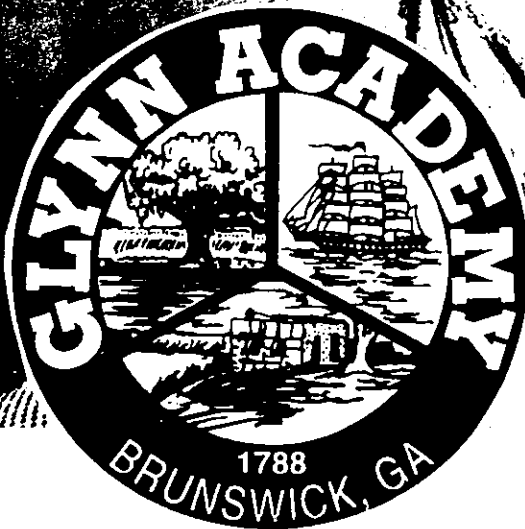
"FOR THOU ART WITH ME"
