Colonel Thomas Page was an original patentee of land in Virginia.

Nugent's Cavaliers and Pioneers, p. 521 shows that Col. Thomas Page owned

land next to Thomas Lucas and Valentine Allen. Same reference, p. 480:

Valentine Allen patented 430 A. Feb. 20th 1662, on south side of the Rappahan-
nook River between the branches of a creek running nigh land of John Jennings,
one-half of same having been granted to Thomas Page 21 April 1657, who assign-
ed to Allen.
